NOTICE OF THE DECISION OF THE FINANCIAL REGULATION STANDARDS AND
ACCREDITATION (F) COMMITTEE OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INSURANCE
COMMISSIONERS (NAIC) REINSTATING THE ACCREDITATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE
COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE OF PUERTO RICO

To Whom It May Concern:

The Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) hereby notifies that the Financial Regulation Standards and Accreditation (F) Committee of the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) has reinstated Puerto Rico's accreditation after the OCI demonstrated compliance with the requirements set forth in Part A of the Accreditation Manual and submitted the OCI Corrective Action Plan on December 19, 2025.

This result confirms that Puerto Rico meets the regulatory standards applicable to multistate international insurers and shows the rigorous work, discipline, and consistency of the OCI, with the support of the Government of Puerto Rico, to strengthen financial oversight and the stability of the insurance industry.

The review conducted by the NAIC covered the impact of Act No. 130-2025, as well as the updating of regulations, procedures, and operational practices implemented by the OCI, recognizing the progress achieved by reinstating the accreditation. The OCI will continue to report periodically to the NAIC and maintain ongoing communication with that organization regarding each international insurer and reinsurer and each multistate international insurer and reinsurer that applies for authorization from the OCI under the International Insurance Center.

The OCI reaffirms its commitment to transparency, effective oversight of the insurance industry, and consumer protection in Puerto Rico. We will continue to work diligently and in close collaboration with the NAIC to maintain and strengthen compliance with NAIC accreditation standards.

We urge the entire insurance industry to continue to comply not only with NAIC standards, but also to strictly uphold the Puerto Rico Insurance Code and its regulations, thereby

demonstrating that we are a serious and responsible jurisdiction committed to best regulatory practices.
